Dear Parent/Carer,

Assalamu Alaikum/ Peace be with you

I hope that you and your family are well. Firstly, let me thank you for your continuous support through the first half of the Autumn Term.

We are working hard to comply with Government and Trust guidance so as to ensure that your daughter receives the support that she needs in her education and the changes that arise, ensuring that the school is safe for pupils and staff. The safety and well-being of everyone in the school is of paramount importance.

When the pupils return after the half-term break, following Government guidance, we will continue with the measures in place to ensure everyone in our school community is safe. The school will open as normal on Monday 2 November, see attached school term dates.

We need your daughter to follow each of the rules outlined:

1. Only attend school if you and all members of your household do not have Covid-19 related symptoms.
2. Wear a mask or face covering if using public transport. Wear a face covering in school communal areas.
3. Arrive to school and leave to go home at the designated time. Do not congregate in school or outside at the start or end of the day. Use pelican or zebra crossings. Do not cross Bath road at any other point, for your and other road user's safety.
4. Use sanitiser to disinfect hands on entering and leaving school and each lesson within the day. sanitizers are in every classroom. Wash hands with soap regularly during the day at your allocated break and lunch times.
5. Always stick to your 'bubble' and 'homebase'.
6. Always avoid physical contact. No hugs, shaking hands, sharing stationary etc. Maintain as much distance from others as possible.
7. In the classroom, do not move tables or chairs. Avoid touching displays and other surfaces. Wipe specialist equipment before and after use with the wipes provided in each classroom.
8. At break and lunch times, go outside or to your designated venue. Maintain a safe distance from others.
9. Do not share belongings (stationery, food etc.) with others.
10. Use your designated toilets only. Only enter the toilets if there is a free cubicle.

Thank you once again for all the support that you give to your daughter, and for working with us. I am very proud of the way in which our school has pulled together to look after each other during the pandemic.

Have a lovely half term and support your daughter to complete all set work ready for the next half Autumn term starting Monday 2 November 2020.
