**RE: Eid Arrangements** 

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Assalaamu Alaikum (Peace Be Upon You)

I am writing to confirm arrangements for the forthcoming Eid.

Depending on the moon sighting, school will be closed for all students either:

- Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> May and Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> May, or
- Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> May and Friday 14<sup>th</sup> May.

If the moon is sighted on the evening of Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> May, school will be closed on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> May.

If the moon is not sighted on the evening of Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> May, school will be closed on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> and Friday 14<sup>th</sup> May.

All parents will be advised of the Eid holidays by text message on the evening of Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> May.

Please contact the school and ask to speak to the school Office if you have any queries about the Eid holiday.

On <u>Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May</u>, students will have an activity in school to mark the end of Ramadhaan and to celebrate Eid. As part of the day, students will have normal lessons, 1 to 5, but will also:

- Be able to attend in non-uniform (Eid-themed clothes).
- Complete a faith activity/Quiz during lesson 6.
- Winners announced for the Form board with an Ice cream van onsite for the winners
- Enjoy a special meal during their lunch break.
- A goody bag to take home including samosa, krispy kreme, sweets and a drink

The school will pay for the cost of the Eid meal and goody bag. As part of the non-uniform day, students are asked to bring a minimum of £1. All funds raised will be used to support Shine Charity's projects with locally impoverished families. Thank you for your continued support.

We ask for your special prayers for our school family and community during these final few days of the holy month of Ramadhaan.
