Monday 12th July (Sports Uniform)

Sports Day is scheduled at the **Salt Hill Park, Slough**. Pupils and staff members will walk to the venue from school at 8.15am. Pupils must arrive to school as normal for registration and sports day briefing. **All pupils** are expected to come to school in **full PE uniform** and trainers.
