Over the weekend, the Prime Minister advised that there would be additional precautions to minimise the risk of infection.

- Delivered online lessons so that students who are isolating can continue their learning.
- Been able to vaccinate our students aged 12 and over with parental consent.
- Continued to ventilate our classrooms to reduce the risk of infection.
