Re: Year 8 Activities Week (Monday 18th July – 21st July 2022)

Monday 18th July (Sports Uniform)

Sports Day is scheduled at the **Salt Hill Park, Slough**. Pupils and staff members will walk to the venue from school at 8.15am. Pupils must arrive to school as normal at 8am for registration and sports day briefing. **All pupils** are expected to come to school in **full PE uniform** and trainers. PE staff will send out further communication about the event. Pupils will have to bring a **packed lunch**, healthy snacks, and plenty of water for the day. Lunch will be provided to FSM pupils. We expect it will be a very hot day so pupils should carry sunscreen and protective hats. Pupils are expected to return to school for a normal finish time at **3.05pm**.

Tuesday, 19th July (Comfortable clothes)

Chessington Trip. Pupils will have to bring a **packed lunch**, healthy snacks, and plenty of water for the day. Lunch will be provided to FSM pupils. We expect it will be a very hot day so pupils should carry sunscreen and protective hats. Pupils are expected to return to school between **4.30-5.00pm** depending on traffic. Wednesday 20th July (Comfortable clothes)

Bournemouth Beach Day. Pupils must arrive to school on time for 8am registration as normal. We aim to **return to school between 4.30-5.00pm** depending on traffic.
