**Eid Ul Adha celebration and non-uniform day for charity**

We pray that you and your family are in good health, Insha-Allah.

The 10 days of The Month of Dhul Hijjah are very sacred. It has been reported in a narration, The Prophet (Peace be upon him) said: ***“There are no days in which righteous deeds are more beloved to Allah than these 10 days (Dhul Hijjah).” (Bukhari)***

Therefore, we are writing to inform you that we will be hosting activities for our pupils on the importance of Hajj and Eid Ul Adha through assembly and form time activities.

School will be closed on **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> July** and we will be celebrating Eid Ul Adha with pupils on **Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2022**.

Pupils will come in non-uniform with their **laneyards**. The clothing must be according to the Islamic ethos (no jeans, jewellery, high heels, make up etc) and the theme will be ‘Cultural clothing’. We are requesting a minimum of £2 contribution towards our Trust Charity – Shine. At the end of the school day, we will have ice cream vans onsite for pupils to purchase; pupils will need to bring in extra money to make purchases.

On the day, pupils will be treated with free snacks and treats. Lessons will run as normal and therefore all pupils will need to bring in their stationery and books as normal.
