## **RE: Trip to Hi5 events at Reading Activity Centre**

I write to invite your daughter to take part in an exciting trip to Hi5 taking place at Reading Activity Centre. This trip will help year 7 pupils to improve their communication and teamwork skills as well as allowing them to develop new friendships in secondary school. Reading Activity Centre provides a range of exciting activities aimed at young people, with instructors leading and supervising each task. Tasks include:

**Human Table Football** – Everyone has played the tabletop version, now experience the full Human version. With the pitch over 30 feet long and 20 feet wide surrounded by an inflatable, the players are harnessed to the poles, which means they can only move sideways and have limited movement during the game. Goalkeepers need to be on form as there's no off-side rule in this game! Subs are allowed, and a foam football is used to prevent injury in this closely fought battle with 2 teams.

**Last Man Standing**— 6 players must jump and duck the sweeper arm rotating around the inflatable bed, as in the title last person stood on their podium will be the winner. This is a high energy entertaining game.

**Bungee Basketball** - Compete against your peers in Bungee Basketball; score as many baskets for your team in the time given to be declared the dream team. This sport requires accuracy for free throws and endurance against the tensile strength of the bungee cord.

Challenge me – Various teambuilding challenges, which will test your agility, balance and teamwork.

**The trip will take place on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> of October 2022** with pupils leaving the school by coach **at 8:30am** and returning by **3:00pm**. Your daughter is to attend school at the normal timing.

Pupils are <u>not</u> expected to wear school uniform on the day and are advised to dress in clothing and footwear suitable for the physical tasks and activities that they will be taking part in. They will also need a packed lunch, water bottle and a healthy snack. A free school meal will be provided for eligible pupils. If you require financial support, please do write to me, stating the reason for support.

The cost of the trip includes all the activities and travel. A payment of £25 and can only be paid for via ParentPay. The school does <u>not</u> accept cheques or cash payments. Please contact the school's finance office if you need support in using your ParentPay account.

If you would like your daughter to take part in this trip, please make the **payment by Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2022** and **return the reply slip by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022** 

Parents should please note that we expect all students to participate in this trip as it is an important part of their transition to secondary school. If due to medical reasons etc. your child is unable to attend, they are still expected to attend school and will have work set for them.
