The Year 11 Parents' Evening will take place on Thursday 19th January 2023 from 4.00pm – 7.00pm. This is an important opportunity to discuss your daughter's academic progress with her subject teachers in the final year of her GCSE studies. Yesterday your daughter brought home her most recent academic report and a copy of her Mock Exam performance. Please do review each subject result with your daughter. You will be able to discuss the report card and recent test results with her teachers at the Parents' Evening.

We would urge you to take this opportunity to find out how your daughter is progressing, with praise and support as required to ensure future success. Students are expected to attend the Parents' Evening along with parents. From Monday 9th January your daughter will be able to make appointments with her class teacher. **A form to support this process will be given to her at the start of the day on Monday. Before Monday, please confirm with her your availability so that she can make appointments at times that are convenient.**

Please see Parents' Evening as an opportunity to make the most of the **last 4 months of school for your child's future success**.

- We ask that you arrive 10 minutes before your first appointment so that you can start the minute the teacher is free, allowing the evening to run smoothly.
- You will be asked to sign in at reception and will also be asked to confirm that the contact details we have for you are correct.
- We also ask that you stick to your five-minute slot with the teacher, so other parents can also receive adequate time with the teacher.
- Please recognise that face to face Parents' Evenings can overrun. We will try our best to ensure the evening runs smoothly.

I would recommend that you try to see all your daughter's teachers where possible. **Mrs Monteiro, our Head of Year 11, will also be available for parent meetings to discuss future pathways and any other concerns.**
