**Re: Year 9 Activities Week (Monday 17<sup>th</sup> July – 20<sup>th</sup> July 2023)**

**Monday 17<sup>th</sup> July (School Uniform)**

**Career/Teambuilding Activities and Poetry Workshop.** Pupils will be involved in a carousel of rich activities that are being offered by internal and external providers. The aim is to give pupils the opportunity to learn new skills and develop camaraderie through creative teambuilding activities. Activities on the day include creative games (indoor and outdoor), a poetry show, and a workshop. School day as normal.

**Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July (PE/Sports Uniform)**
