- · You live in an IMD Decile 1 or 2 postcode*
- You live in a POLAR4 Quintile 1 postcode**
- · You have received Free School Meals within the last 6 years
- · You have a diagnosed disability or long-term health condition
- You are a young carer
- · You have experience of living within care
- You are a forced migrant (a refugee or an asylum-seeking young person)
- You are from a Gypsy, Roma, Traveller, Showperson or Boater community
